

Pipeline replacement from the beginning of March to the end of May 2024

Traffic restrictions main road Lauterbrunnen

The up to 100-year-old service pipes in the main road are in need of renovation. The municipality of Lauterbrunnen will therefore adapt them to the latest state of the art in three stages. The 300 metre-long project is located between the Hotel Schützen and the Hotel Oberland. The first construction phase will start at the beginning of March and last until the end of May 2024, with further stages planned for 2025 and 2026.



One-way traffic through the village

- Pedestrians can walk on one side of the pavement.
- Access to properties, hotels and shops is guaranteed - at least on foot.
- Short closures of the access roads are unavoidable.
- Longer waiting times must be taken into account when travelling through.

- To prevent long queues in the village, „traffic lights“ are installed to regulate traffic.
- A signalling service is also provided for very heavy traffic.
- The bus service is available at all times. If necessary and for free journeys, the traffic lights can be switched to green from the bus.
